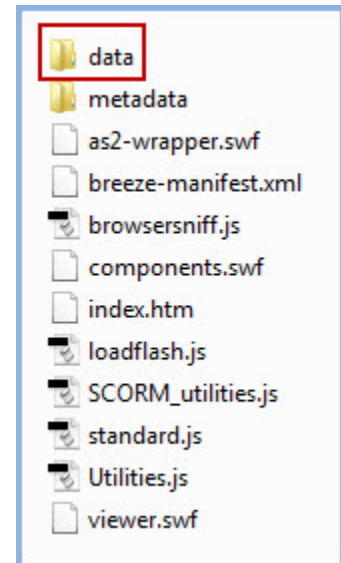
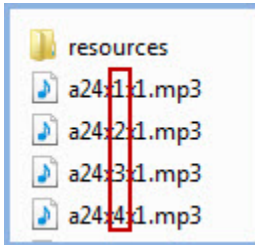


Converting an Existing Presenter to a Mix

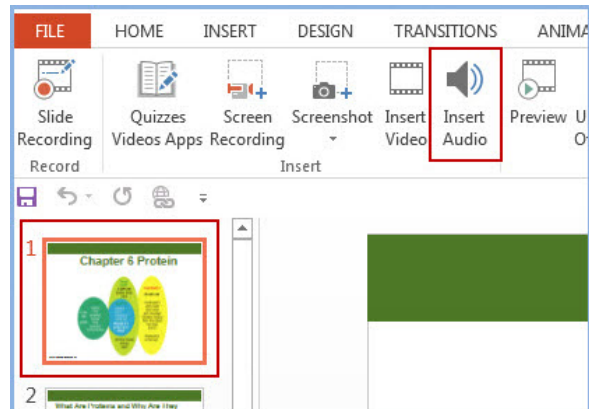
You need the original PowerPoint and the audio files for each slide

1. A published Adobe Presenter can be converted to a Mix presentation if you have the original PowerPoint and the folder created when the Adobe Presenter was published.
2. The published Presenter folder will contain a folder titled “data” which will have all of the mp3 audio files, one file per PowerPoint slide.



Steps to Convert

1. Open the PowerPoint file.
2. Open the Mix menu.
3. Starting with the first slide, select Insert Audio.
4. Search for the Presenter folder that contains the data folder, open data, select the first mp3 file, then select Insert.
5. The PowerPoint menu will rest and you need to repeat steps 3 and 4 selecting the second PowerPoint slide and second mp3, continuing this process until you have added audio to all of the slides.
6. When audio has been loaded to a slide this audio symbol will appear in the middle of the slide. Mousing over the icon allows you to play the audio.



7. When you are done save the PowerPoint, Export to Video, and then Upload to Office Mix.
